OTHER CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY PARKS ATTRACTIONS

Fred J. Cusimano Westside Overland Trail stretches 24 miles from near the Pennsylvania-New York boundary in the Town of Harmony to the south side of Chautauqua Gorge.

Earl Cardot Eastside Overland Trail extends from the Twenty-Eighth Creek Road in the Town of Gerry and proceeds northerly for 19 miles to Canadaway Creek in the Town of Arkwright.

The Marden E. Cobb Waterway Trail contains sections of Gassadaga Creek and Conewango Creek and together provides 52 miles of generally flat-water canoeing. There are launch sites into the waterway from public property. A map of the waterway indicates facilities for parking and access to the waterways.

John R. Luensman Overview Park is located at the top of the Lake Erie escarpment in the Town of Portland, adjoining Thayer Road. There is a great view of Lake Erie, including the lake plain, villages along the north shore, the Canadian south shore and into downtown Buffalo.

Tom Erlandson Overview Park is located on Oak Hill Road in the Town of Carroll, east of Frewsburg. The park is at an elevation of 2,080 ft., making the park the second highest elevation in the county. The elevation of the park affords one a panoramic view of the surrounding countryside, including Chautauqua Lake to the west, Onoville valley to the east, and the Allegheny Mountains to the south.

Abe Matteson Trailrace Park is within the Village of Falconer and is on the north bank of the Chadakoin River. Entrance to the park is from East Everett Street and adjoining the east end of the Fancher Chair Company. Ample parking, picnic facilities, trails and a canoe launch are offered at this restful site.

Adirondack lean-tos, latrines, fireplaces and tables are at campsites along the overland trails and waterways. The trails are well marked. Parking is available near or adjoining the trail at various road crossings. Hiking, skiing, snowshoeing and mountain biking are permitted on the trails. Maps are available for these facilities.
